Del Webb Lifestyle Makes Fitness, Staying Active A Breeze All Year Long

SUMMERVILLE, SC – The residents at Del Webb Charleston give new meaning to the term Active Adult lifestyle. From regular workouts in the community’s state-of-the-art fitness center to organizing bicycle rides through Cane Bay, they’re always busy staying fit with a bit of fun thrown in.

“Our residents are always coming up with new and fun ways to get together,” said Jennifer Burton, Lifestyle Director with Del Webb Charleston. “The fitness center is always busy and everyone seems to enjoy the heated indoor pool during the cooler months. Rich Becchetti is a regular at the fitness center, which has free weights, treadmills, elliptical machines and also offers classes.

“I’m in the gym every day,” Becchetti said. “It’s one of the greatest things about this community because I can do my own fitness program six days a week.”

The indoor pool is heated at the 20,000-square-foot Resort Clubhouse and residents swim laps and enjoy the ability to swim all year long. The pool even has a ramp for easy access.

Olive Corriveau works out regularly in the indoor pool. She said that she finds the convenience of the amenities also provides opportunities to make friends.

“A good part of the amenities center is the socializing, plus we don’t have to travel far to get to the gym,” she said. “It’s right here in our back yard, so we can work out with our neighbors and stay fit at the same time.”

The Del Webb lifestyle for people aged 55 or better includes a full schedule of activities, from book clubs to walking groups. There are outings to historic place in Charleston, theater, plus residents stay active with the community’s many organizations.

“One of the reasons that people move here is because of the active lifestyle,” Burton said. “No matter what you like to do, it’s here at Del Webb Charleston.”

Outdoor amenities include tennis, pickle ball, bocce ball and sidewalks. There’s another heated outdoor pool and hot tub, pool house, fire pit, a dog park and open lawn area for entertainment and outdoor events.

“Our sidewalks and the gentle terrain here make it easy to walk and/or ride bicycles,” Burton said. “We’ve organized several neighborhood rides and as the weather warms, there will be even more outdoor activities.”
